Consultation – Fixed term temporary employment

In accordance with Section 110 (1) (b) of the PSM Act, where CHS intends to employ a person on a fixed term temporary employment greater than or equal to twelve months, but less than five years, CHS will consult with the principal unions about the need to advertise the position on a temporary fixed term temporary employment arrangement.
