Re: Closure of Works in the Office of the Chief Executive, eHealth NSW

The Office of the Chief Executive (OCE) directorate within eHealth NSW includes several corporate teams, including Communication Services, Policy and Executive Services, Privacy, Business Plan Implementation Office and Business Resilience. Collectively, these teams serve an important role in supporting eHealth NSW realise its vision of a digitally enabled and integrated health system, delivering patient-centred health experiences and quality health outcomes.

In light of the current fiscal environment, the reduction in capital funding and finalisation of large ICT programs and initiatives, several positions within the OCE will be deleted as they are no longer required.

Staff consultation meetings have been held on 6 November 2024 to inform staff of the proposed changes and to seek their feedback. Staff have been requested to provide formal feedback to eHealth NSW by close of business 20 November 2024. It would be appreciated if your organisation and members could also provide any feedback regarding the proposal by **close of business 20 November 2024**.

It is anticipated that eighteen (18) permanent employees will be deemed affected as a result of the change.
