**Re: Change to the use of CARP's task system in Wyong Emergency
Department**

Central Coast Local Health District (the District) wishes to advise the HSU of a variation to the use of CARP task system in Wyong Emergency Department. The CARP's task system will not be used for internal tasks within the Emergency department during 6am – 10pm.

The change will incorporate the development of a PSA team leader role for AM & PM shifts. Current staff will be offered this opportunity. This role will include the application of a leading hand allowance. The CARP's task system will continue to be used during the nightshift period. As a safeguard the use of carp task system is still available during any high activity periods.

This notification is made under the Clause 1 and 2 of the Health Employees Conditions of Employment (State) Award.

Consultation has taken place with the employees impacted and the changes are expected to officially commence over the next few months.

There will be no changes to the conditions of employment or rate of pay as a result of this move.
